## PRE-HEALTH SCIENCES

In order to give students the greatest possible assistance in reaching their career goals, the program has been designed to encourage students to work exceptionally hard throughout their time at Wagner College and gain as much experience as possible. This commitment to hard work will prepare students for entry into their chosen professional school. Wagner offers a variety of health related programs. The Wagner College Pre-Professional Health Advisory Committee has responsibility for oversight of these programs. This committee assists students with their overall preparation for entry into professional programs, guides students through the application process, and writes committee letters endorsing the students' bids for acceptance. ## PRE-LAW

Prospective law students are free to choose among the wide variety of majors offered at Wagner College. In addition to satisfying the specific requirements of a major,

students are encouraged to select a few law-related courses in business, philosophy, political science, and sociology.

Students who are planning to apply for admission to a theological seminary are urged to include in their college program a foreign language, sociology, anthropology, philosophy, religious studies, education, English, and history. All pre-ministry students should plan their work in consultation with their advisor and the Chaplain.

## JOINT DEGREE PROGRAM

*Optometry B.S./O.D.*

The State University of New York, State College of Optometry in conjunction with Wagner College offers a seven-year combined degree program in optometric education. This program is designed for highly motivated high school graduates, whose primary career goal is optometry. A successful graduate from the program will have a bachelor of science degree from Wagner College and a doctor of optometry from SUNY College of Optometry.
